For the best herd of beef cattle, all animals to be bona fide property of the competitor and have been in his possession for three calendar months prior to the closing date. All animals on the farm to be shown

A replica of the Challenge Cup will be presented by the society.

Stores and Finished Beef Cattle Class A2

For the best herd of potential Stores and Finished cattle (not necessarily home bred)
All cattle to be shown.

First Prize: £10, Second 6, Third £4

Dairy Herd Class A3

For the best dairy herd taking into consideration dairy cows and stock bulls.
All dairy cows to be shown

First Prize: The H & F Bignall Perpetual Challenge Cup and £10
Second £6, Third £4

Dairy young stock Class A4

For the best dairy young stock, taking into consideration up to and including
In-calf heifers and bulling heifers.

First Prize: The Peter Perpetual Challenge Trophy and £10
Second £6, Third £4

Commercial Flock of Sheep Class A5

For the best flock of commercial sheep.

First Prize The B.H.A.S Perpetual Challenge Cup

Milling Wheat Class A6

For the best crop of winter sown Milling Wheat (groups 1 & 2).
Not less than four acres, the whole field to be shown.

First Prize: The Western Arable Services Ltd Perpetual Challenge Cup and £10, Second £6, Third £4

Feed Wheat Class A7

For the best crop of winter sown Feed wheat- Whole field to be shown
First Prize: The A. Nichols (Cow Mills) Cup and £10, second £ 6, Third £4

Winter Barley Class A8

For the best crop of winter sown Barley. Whole Field to be shown.

First Prize: The Uley Mercury Challenge Cup and £10, Second £6, Third £4
Spring Sown Cereals Class A9

Best crop Spring Wheat Barley or Oats – Whole field to be shown

First Prize - £10 Second £6 Third £4

Winter Rape Class A10

For the best crop of winter sown OSR. Whole field to be shown
First Prize: £10, Second £6, Third £4

Alternative Crops Class A11

For the best Alternative crop. Whole field to be shown
First Prize: £10, Second £6, Third £4

Maize Class A14

For the best crop of standing forage Maize. Not less than four acres, the whole field to be shown.
First prize: The B.H.A.S Forage Maize Perpetual Challenge Cup Kindly presented by
Pioneer HI-Bred (UK) Ltd and £10, Second £6, Third £4

Permanent Pasture Class A15

Best Permanent Pasture not less than four acres, the whole field to be shown, must have been
sown for at least six years.

First Prize: the Twynning Ash Perpetual Trophy and £10, Second £6, Third £4

Grass Ley Class A16

To be judged on uniformity of growth, quality and density of sward also productivity.
Not less than four acres the whole field to be shown.

First Prize £10, Second £6, Third £4

Grass Silage Class A17

Best opened clamp of this year's grass silage. Analysis required.

First Prize: The Gloucester Animal Feeds Perpetual Challenge Cup and £10, Second £6, Third £4

Maize Silage Class A18

Best Opened clamp of this year's maize silage. Analysis required.

First Prize: The Bio-tal Agric Products Perpetual Challenge Cup and £10, Second £6, Third £4

Alternative Enterprise A19

An additional enterprise to the farming business initiated in the last five years.

First prize: RMC Cup and £10, Second £6, Third £4

Best Garden Class A20

Open to all members, whole garden to be judged. Class may be split at judged discretion.

First Prize: £10, Second £6, Third £4

Classes A1-A19

There must be a minimum of 3 entries in any class or that class will be deleted.
